



As we approach the start of the 2021-2022 school year, it is important to remember that all students registered to a schoolhouse will return to in-person instruction. As a result, distance learning (MSO) is not an option when school resumes in Miami-Dade County Public Schools this Fall.

Those parents expressing an interest in having their students remain in a virtual setting may opt to withdraw from their current school and enroll at [Miami-Dade Virtual School \(MDVS\)](#).

- MDVS will employ Miami-Dade County Public Schools teachers and facilitators to provide instruction.
- MDVS is open to grades K through 12.
- Miami-Dade County Public Schools will offer Exceptional Student Education (ESE) and English Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) consultation services to Miami-Dade Virtual School's elementary, middle, and high school programs.
